With all the neighborhoods in all the cities across two counties, we know there are stories to share about some part of history that makes your favorite location special. What don't we know about it?

For example:

- Your topic may be something not widely known that had a big impact on a place.
- Or It may be about a person who did something great or awful in your region.
- Or it could be about an incident that changed the course of events where you are.
- It could be that your location was the first to do something, or the last to do it well.
- It could be that only you know something about the history of a neighborhood.

**Believe it or not, we want to know about it!**



You don't have to actually live in the neighborhood about which you want to speak. And you don't have to be a professional speaker, writer, or historian. Great presentations come from those who care, and we know you care about your neighborhood! Since this is a history conference, please share something that happened at least 20 years ago. Geographic area: COH organization member range from southern Orange County to northern Baja California. Please use this region as your guide for sharing a historic talk.

**Conference Format:** 16-18 speakers over two days, each giving a 20-minute talk with 10 minutes for Q&A. Speakers must have a PowerPoint presentation (with lots of photos please, not so heavy on text).

We're happy to work with you to refine your topic to make sure it fits the theme. Submittals will be reviewed by the Conference Committee. Please share your knowledge about your neighborhood!
